



Smoke & Speed Dirt Drags Rules

General Rules

1. All drivers must have a valid driver's license or permit. No competitors under 16 years of age. Any competitors between the ages of 16 years and 18 years, needs a parent/guardian signature on entry form. For New Jersey races, NJ state law does not allow any drivers under the age of 18 years.
2. ALL drivers must wear helmet.
3. Safety restraint system must be worn and in proper working order.
4. Any driver using injectables MUST wear a fire jacket. Failure to do so will result in forfeit of points, loss of payouts and/or up to a year suspension from competition in all Smoke and Speed events. This is an insurance requirement and must be taken seriously.
5. Failure to follow all safety rules and/or wear any of the mandated safety gear will result in non-refundable disqualification. Please read all safety rules in accordance with your class(es).
6. No bikes, ATV's, trikes, dirt bikes or the like, are allowed in competition.
7. No alcohol or drugs allowed in the pits. Any drivers under the influence will be subject to immediate ejection from the event.
8. Registration for points must happen before points will be counted. Points fee for the season will be \$100. Guaranteed payouts at every event and year end for designated classes. Registration fee for points members \$20/race. Non-members \$30/race.
9. Grudge races are welcome at every event. Fee for grudge races are \$10/race. At the end of the scheduled classes grudge racing will take place. Drivers can register before or during grudges. All safety rules apply to grudge races, NO EXCEPTIONS.

Diesels

Manual Class

1. All trucks must be of $\frac{3}{4}$ ton or 1 ton size.
2. All trucks must be full manual transmission. Manual valve bodies are prohibited.
3. No turbo limitations.
4. Injectables are allowed. See General Rules for safety requirements.
5. If the muffler or catalytic converter were changed from stock, turbo bolts are MANDATORY. Two (2) $\frac{3}{8}$ inch diameter bolts must be installed through exhaust pipe in a cross pattern within one (1) inch of each other and as close to the turbo as practical.

Open Unlimited Class

1. Open to any vehicles.
2. No turbo limitations. Turbo bolts are mandatory. Two (2) 3/8 inch diameter bolts must be installed through exhaust pipe in a cross pattern within one (1) inch of each other and as close to the turbo as practical.
3. Injectables are allowed. See General Rules for safety requirements.
4. Tube chassis, fiberglass body, back-half, wheel tub, etc. trucks are permitted.
5. Any added weight must be secured. Any loss of weight will result in immediate disqualification.

Super Singles

1. Single charger only. No size limits.
2. No injectables.
3. If the muffler or catalytic converter were changed from stock, turbo bolts are MANDATORY. Two (2) 3/8 inch diameter bolts must be installed through exhaust pipe in a cross pattern within one (1) inch of each other and as close to the turbo as practical.

Workstock

1. The turbocharger is limited to a stock-appearing, OEM/Factory make specific charger only. Turbochargers from different years in the same make may be interchanged, no adapters to accept other model turbo. 6.4 liter Powerstroke engines may utilize the factory twin-turbo configuration and must retain OEM turbos.
2. All exhaust must exit rearward of the drivers compartment. No hoodstacks. No side fender exhaust.
3. Must be DOT tire. No alterations or modifications permitted.
4. No injectables.
5. Must have full OEM body.

OEM Charger Class

1. OEM charger mandatory. No wheels, modifications or alterations are permitted.
2. No injectables.
3. Must be DOT tires. No alterations or modifications permitted.
4. All exhaust must exit rearward of the drivers compartment. No hoodstacks. No side fender exhaust.
5. Must have full OEM body.
