

# Smoke & Speed Dirt Drags Rules

## General Rules

1. All drivers must have a valid driver's license or permit. No competitors under 16 years of age. Any competitors between the ages of 16 years and 18 years, needs a parent/guardian signature on entry form. For New Jersey races, NJ state law does not allow any drivers under the age of 18 years.
2. ALL drivers must wear SNELL 2010 or 2015 approved helmet and OEM or SFI approved safety restraint.
3. Safety restraint system must be worn and in proper working order.
4. Any driver using injectables MUST wear a fire jacket. Failure to do so will result in forfeit of points, loss of payouts and/or up to a year suspension from competition in all Smoke and Speed events. This is an insurance requirement and must be taken seriously.
5. Failure to follow all safety rules and/or wear any of the mandated safety gear will result in non-refundable disqualification. Please read all safety rules in accordance with your class(es).
6. No alcohol or drugs allowed in the pits. Any drivers under the influence will be subject to immediate ejection from the event.
7. Grudge races are welcome at every event. Fee for grudge races are \$20/race. At the end of the scheduled classes grudge racing will take place. Drivers can register before or during grudges. All safety rules apply to grudge races, NO EXCEPTIONS.

## Street Gas/Street Diesel

1. Any street legal vehicle may enter in respectable class (i.e. gas vehicles in the gas class, diesel vehicles in the diesel class.)
2. All vehicles must have all sheet metal body panels. No fiberglass clips, beds, etc. will be allowed in the street class.
3. All tires must have DOT stamp. No bar, cut, paddle or scoop tires allowed. No chains, studs or foreign traction devices attached to the tires allowed.
4. No injectables of any kind will be allowed in the street class. All components must be removed from the truck.

## Unlimited Diesel / Unlimited Gas

1. Any diesel vehicle is allowed to compete in the diesel class and gas/alcohol vehicle allowed in the gas class. Fuel additives allowed.
2. Injectables allowed. Anyone utilizing injectables must have a 3.2/A SFI rated firesuit, including gloves and full face shield helmet rated SNELL 2010 or 2015.
3. All tires must have DOT stamp. No bar, cut, paddle or scoop tires allowed. No chains, studs or foreign traction devices attached to the tires allowed.
4. All General Rules apply.
